

ThaiMazing Culture and Beach 12 Days 10 nights Bangkok, Chao Phya River Cruise, Ayuthaya, Suphanburi, Kanchanaburi, & Hua Hin

Day 1 Canada – Bangkok

Depart Canada for Bangkok. Lose one-day while crossing the International Dateline.

Day 2 Arrive Bangkok.

Met by local representative and transferred to hotel.

Accommodation: Amari Watergate Hotel or similar

Day 3 Bangkok (B)

AM: City & Temples Tour.

This morning, experience everyday Thai life as you start the tour through the bustling streets of Bangkok. First stop is Wat Trimit, the Temple of the Golden Buddha, housing the impressive three-metre high, 5-ton, solid gold Buddha, sculpted in the graceful Sukhothai style. This is followed by a visit to Wat Po, the Temple of Reclining Buddha. It features the largest reclining Buddha and the biggest collection of Buddha images in Thailand. Complete the tour with a visit to the White Marble Temple (Wat Benjamaborpitr). Next, marvel the sea of colors at the flower market in Pakklong Talad. Finally drive up Rajdamnern Avenue, a major artery of the city lined by government buildings, the United Nations office and mid-century hotels and shops. Rest of the day is at leisure.

Day 4 Bangkok (B/L/D)

AM: Klongs, Grand Palace & The Emerald Buddha Temple.

After breakfast, enjoy a boat tour on the picturesque Chao Phya River and the “Klongs” (canals). You will observe the serene family homes and temples along the waterways, which gave this city the name “Venice of the East “. We will stop at Wat Arun, the Temple of Dawn, famous for it's 79 m spire and the Grand Palace, Chakri Maha Prasad. The Grand Palace, the former residence of Thai kings is one of the most beautiful samples of an ancient Thai court and was the former residence for the Thai kings.

Ladies and gentlemen are required to dress suitably.

Day 5 Bangkok – Chao Phya River Cruise – Bangsai- Bang-Pa-In – Ayuthaya (B/L/D)

Depart Bangkok in the morning for ac cruise along Chao Phaya River to Wat Chong Lom with lunch on board. Then continue by road to visit BangSai Royal Folk Art and Crafts Center, continue to Bang-Pa-In and visit Summer Palace. Continue to Ayuthaya, the second capital of Thailand. Visits to famous temples including Wat Phra Si Sanphet, Wai Yai Chai Mongkhol and Wat Chai Wattanaram along the way. After tour, transfer to and check in to your hotel. Dinner at hotel.

Accommodation at Krung Sri River Hotel

Day 6 Ayuthaya –Suphanburi- Kanchanaburi (B/L/D)

Leave from Ayuthaya by road to Suphanburi include visit a Buffalo Village to see how farmers use buffaloes in rice farming. Continue to Kanchanaburi to visit Hellfire Pass Museum. Lunch at local Restaurant. Then, take a boat ride along the River Kwai and check-in at the Jungle Raft, a unique floating hotel. Enjoy the scenery of the river from your room or take a walk around the Mon village and see their tribal lifestyle and culture. After dinner, enjoy a tribal dance performance.

Accommodation at River Kwai Jungle Raft

Day 7 Kanchanaburi (B/L/D)

After breakfast transfer by boat to explore a limestone cave (Kaeng Lava Cave) with different types of shapes and columns formed by the crystallization and erosion over hundreds of years. Return back to hotel for lunch and rest of the day is at leisure for you to relax and enjoy the many possibilities at the resort - biking, canoeing, strolling through the herbal garden, cooking lessons, traditional Thai massage or relax in an herbal steam bath.

Day 8 Kanchanburi – Bangkok (B)

After breakfast, depart the resort by boat and proceed to the famous Bridge over the River Kwai. In the afternoon, return to Bangkok. Rest of the day is at leisure.

Accommodation: Amari Watergate Hotel or similar

Day 9 Bangkok – Hua Hin (B)

After Breakfast at hotel transfer to the Evason Hua Hin Resort. Evason Hua Hin is located in the quiet area of Pranburi to the south of Hua Hin and provides calming views of the Gulf of Siam. It is set amongst 20-acres of landscaped lush tropical gardens with lotus ponds.

Accommodation: Evason Hua Hin Resort

Day 10 Bangkok – Hua Hin (B)

Relax and enjoy the sun and beach. Activities such as spa visits, golfing, snorkeling can be arranged with the resort.

Day 11 Bangkok – Hua Hin (B)

Continue to enjoy the sunshine!

Day 12 Hua Hin- Canada (B)

After Breakfast transfer to Bangkok International Airport for flight to Canada.
